## **DIRECTIONS TO MAY LODGE**

Easton, Grantham, Lincolnshire, NG33 5AP

Ideally situated just off the A1, but down a pretty no-through lane, Easton is just 100 miles North of London, between Stamford (16 miles) and Grantham (8 miles) on the Lincolnshire/Rutland border. Grantham is about 65 minutes by high speed train from London King's Cross, and a short taxi-ride will bring you to Easton in under an hour and a half from London.


## DIRECTIONS BY CAR


## From the South

On the A1 go under two bridges at Colsterworth. Just after the 2nd bridge take the left turn to Easton/Ancaster and go up over the bridge. Turn right onto the B6403 and continue north for c. 1 mile. Turn left onto a pretty no-through lane into the little village of Easton, and follow the signs to the Easton Walled Gardens Car Park, which is on the left hand side. Go on past the Car Park and turn left at the sign to May Lodge and The Lofts (if you've got to the Cross, you've gone too far). There is a metal gate with a sign on it. Go through the gate and the car park is on the right hand side. From there follow the signs. May Lodge is just past the car park on the right.

## From the North

5 miles south of Grantham you pass through Great Ponton on the A1. Continue for about 3 miles passing Easton Park and Easton Walled Gardens on your left. Turn left off the A1, signposted B6403 to Easton. After about 1 mile, turn left onto a pretty no-through lane into the little village of Easton, Go





down into the village and follow the signs to the Car Park, which is on the left hand side. Go on past the Car Park and turn left at the sign to May Lodge and The Lofts (if you've got to the Cross, you've gone too far). There is a metal gate with a sign on it. Go through the gate and the car park is on the right hand side. From there follow the signs. May Lodge is just past the car park on the right.

**N.B.** Our postcode is NG33 5AP. However, if you have satellite navigation it will try and bring you into the village from the A1. This is not possible, you need to come in off the B6403, as on the map.

**What3Words** The main gate to May Lodge is found at <u>reclusive.fended.between</u> and your parking space is at <u>cupboards.swan.flick</u>

Please don't park in the main Gardens' car park – this gets locked overnight and we'd hate for your car to be locked in!
